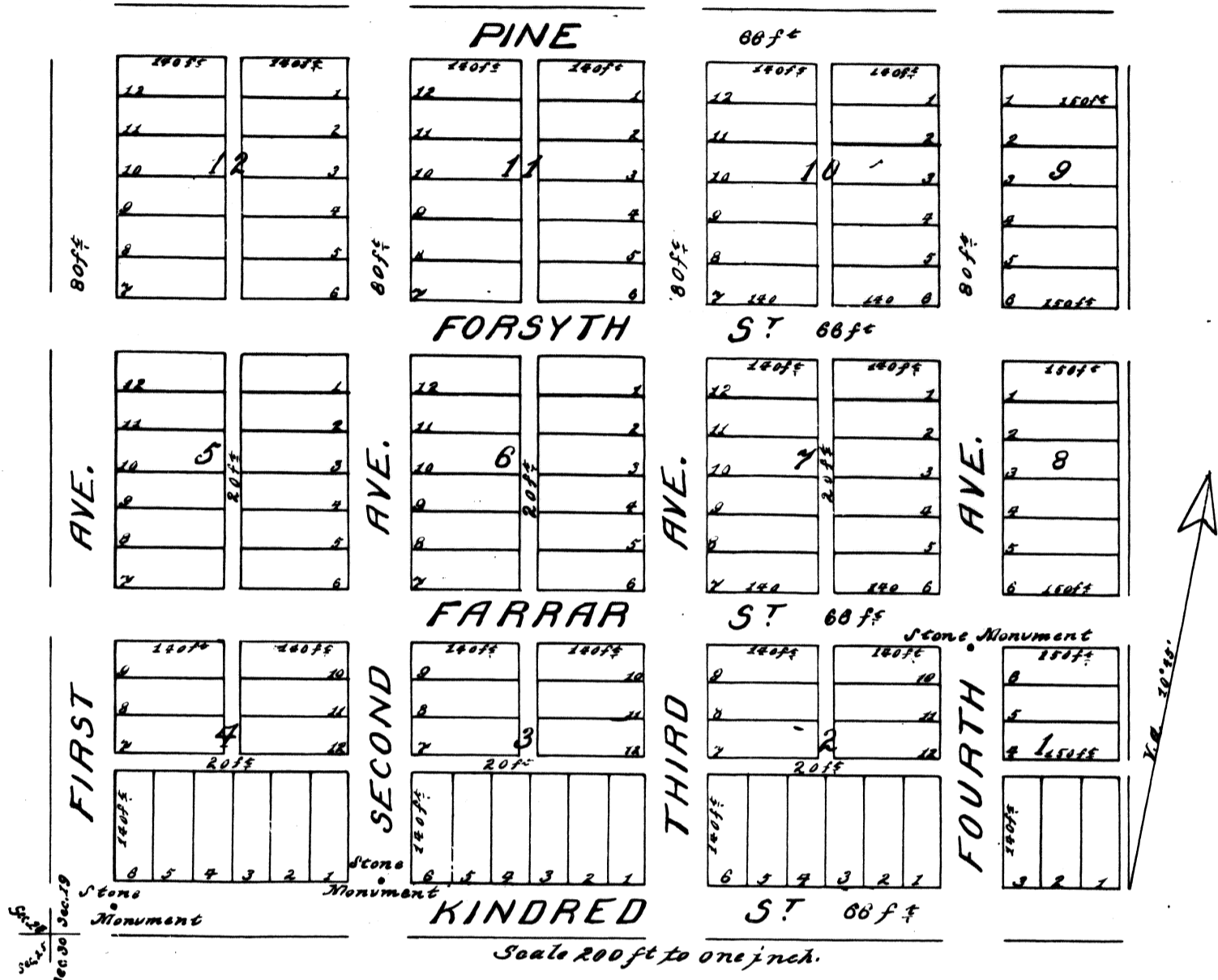


EAST BRAINERD.



The Town of East Brainerd, Crow Wing County, State of Minnesota is located upon the SW¹/₄ of SW¹/₄ Sec 19, Township 45 N Range 30 W. 4th P.M. Streets numbered First, Second, Third & Fourth Avenue run N. & S. on meridian and are 80 ft. wide. Streets running E. & W. are 66 feet wide, alleys are 20 feet wide. The alleys on East Side of 1/2 Blocks is 16 feet wide. Blocks No. 1 are 310 feet by 300 feet all other full blocks are 300 feet square Lots 50 feet by 140 feet, except where otherwise shown on plat. Stone monuments marked there are placed in center of kindred street East Side of First Ave. Center of 2nd Ave. North Side of kindred St. Center of 4th Ave. South Side of Farrar St. Robert K.
