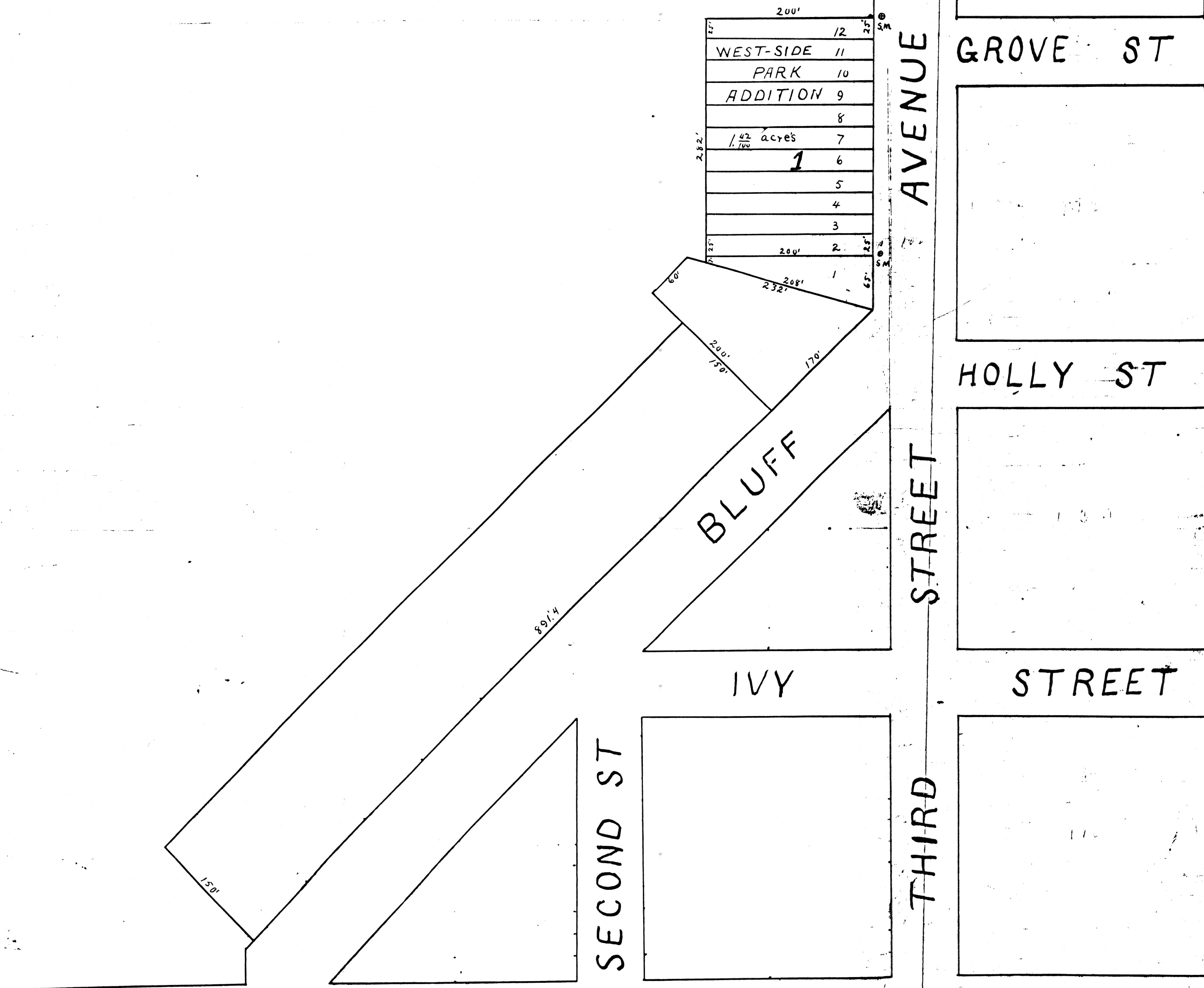


MAP

West-Side Park Addition, to the City of Brainerd, is situated in Lot 4, Section 24, Township No 45 N, Range No 31 W, 4th P.M. Crow Wing County, Minnesota, and contains one and forty two hundredths ($1\frac{42}{100}$) acres. The survey of the same, commences at the south-east corner, of Stiles Addition to the City of Brainerd, as recorded in the Register of Deeds office of the County aforesaid, Thence South 340 feet, Thence N 74° West 268 feet, Thence North 282 feet, Thence East 200 feet, to point of beginning; The lots and Block are of the dimensions shown in the annexed plat; Stone Monuments marked S.M. on the plat - are set in the ground, six inches below the surface, to mark the initial points of the survey of said Addition, as follows, to wit: Five (5) feet East, of the northeast corner of lot one (1), and five (5) feet East of the northeast corner of lot twelve (12), of said Addition, All of which was made by actual survey by me
