### What is Dial-a-Ride?

Dial-a-Ride is a shared ride transit service that will pick you up curbside at your home or place of business. We will arrange to pick you up as near to your requested time as possible. Please let the dispatcher know if you'll need the mobility lift.

Save money by scheduling dial-a-ride requests at least one day prior to need.

Dial-a-Ride hours are 6:00 am to 6:00 pm. Monday—Friday. Space may be limited during peak times.

### Fares

**\$3.00 each trip booked in advance. \$6.00 same day for Brainerd originating trips.**

**\$7.00 each trip booked in advance. \$11 same day for Baxter originating trips.**

### **Ride Passes & Tokens**

.25\$ tokens, \$1 Tokens, \$10 & \$20 ride passes are available at Brainerd City Hall or for purchase online.

A paid fare is required before riding. Smallest coin accepted is a quarter. Cash, Check, tickets or tokens are valid fares. Drivers do not carry change.

### Dial-a-Ride Extras

- ◆ Passengers may request driver assistance to and from doors and help with small packages.
- ◆ Due to space and safety concerns there is a strict 4 bag limit.
- ◆ Buses may not enter driveways or small parking lots. Please be ready to board at the curb.
- ◆ Please be ready 10 minutes prior to your pick up time. The bus may wait only 3 minutes at your location.
- ◆ State law requires that bus drivers and passengers wear seat belts at all times.
- ◆ No shows will result in possible loss of ride privileges. Please give dispatch sufficient notice to cancel your ride.
- ◆ Service animals are allowed. All other animals must be contained in a pet carrier.

All buses are ADA compliant and handicap accessible (lift equipped).
