



CAMPFIRE SAFETY

- Make sure campfires are legal in the area, especially when visiting State parks. Check with the local DNR office for burning bans, including campfires.
- Build campfires away from dry vegetation.
- Never leave a campfire unattended.
- Do not wear scarves, skirts or other loose fitting clothing near a campfire.
- Keep a shovel and plenty of water nearby.
- Do not let children play near campfires.
- When finished with your campfire, douse it with water, stir it with your shovel and douse it with water again.
