**M**atches are not toys. Stay away from matches and lighters.

**N**ever be afraid of firefighters or hide from them.



**O**bey all fire safety rules.

**P**umper trucks pump water to put out fires. Keep safely away from them when they are in action.

**Q**uiz yourself to make sure that you know what to do in case of a fire.

**R**emember to practice your family fire escape plan often.

**S**top, drop and roll if your clothes catch on fire. Cover your face with your hands.

**T**est smoke detectors in your home once a month with your parents.

**U**nplug small appliances when no one is using them. Ask your parents to do this - never do it yourself.

**V**isit the fire station to learn how firefighters help you.



**W**arn adults about any fire hazards you see.
