POLICE CANINE UNIT

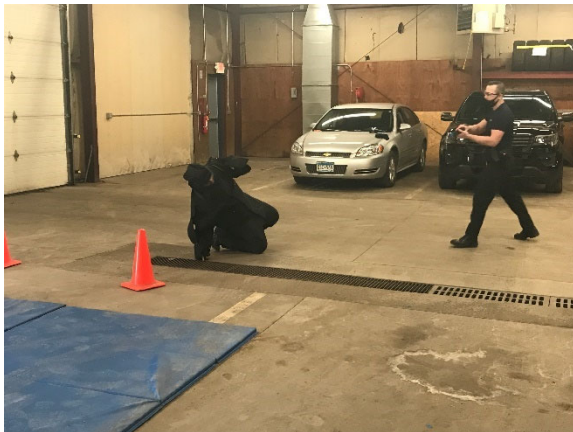
Basic Data Practices for the Front Lines

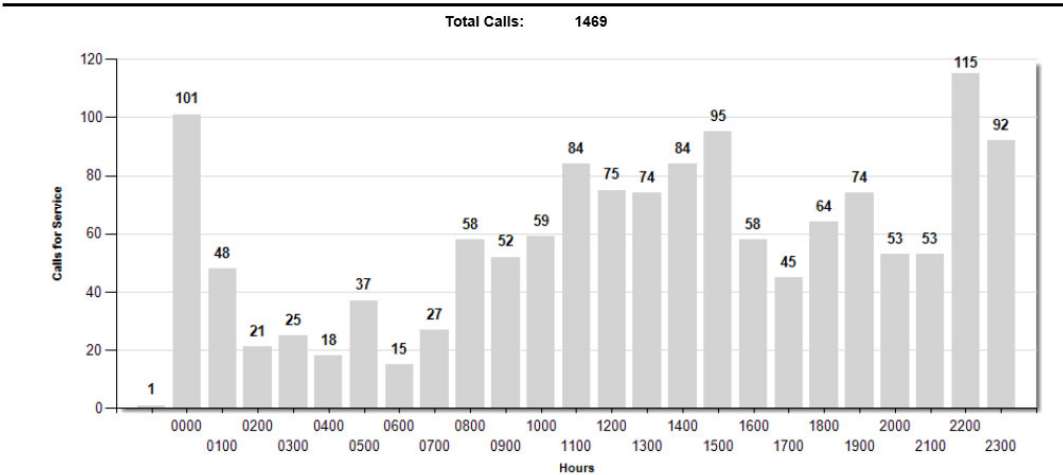

Calls for Service Hourly

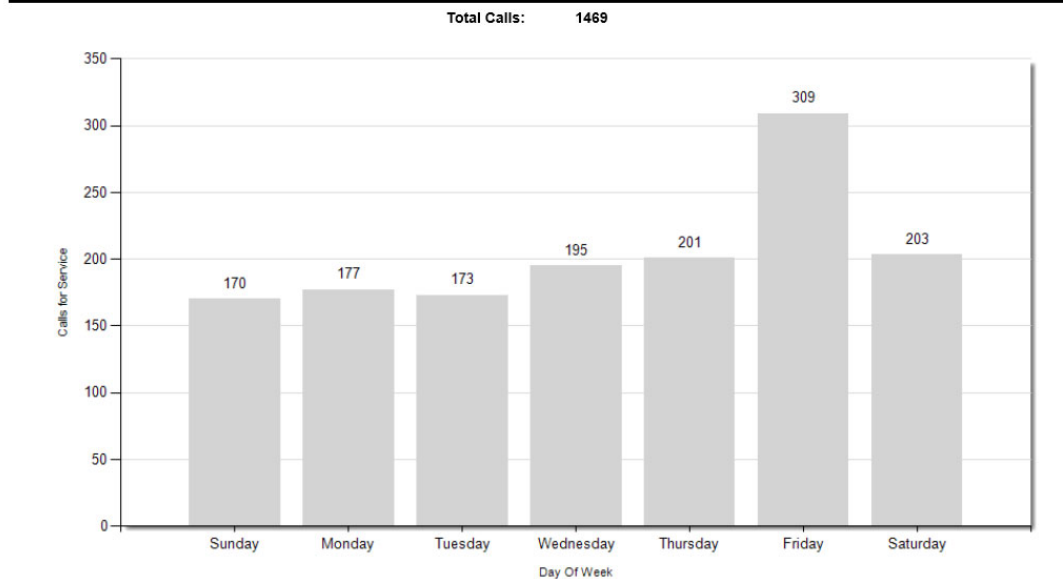

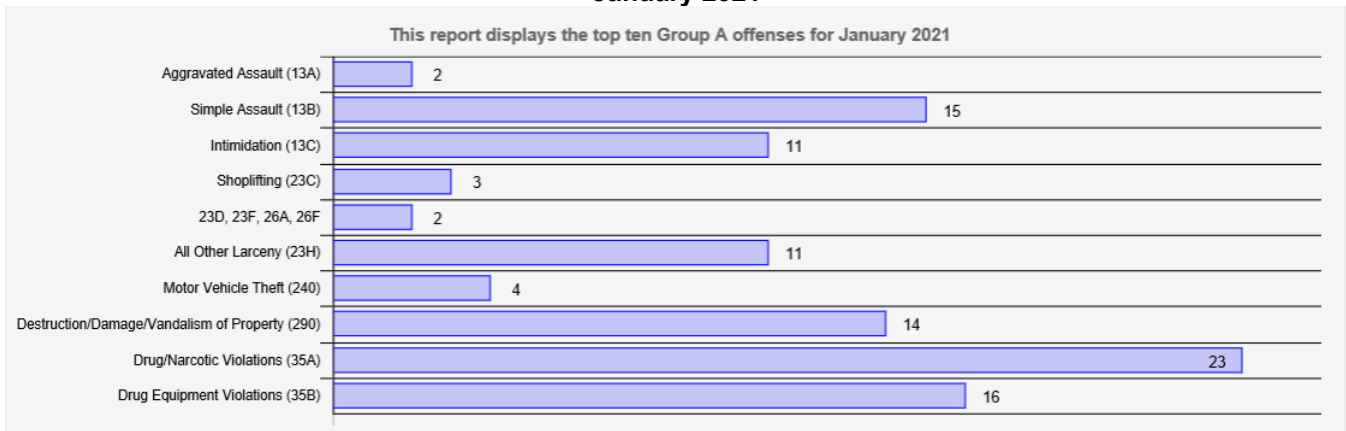

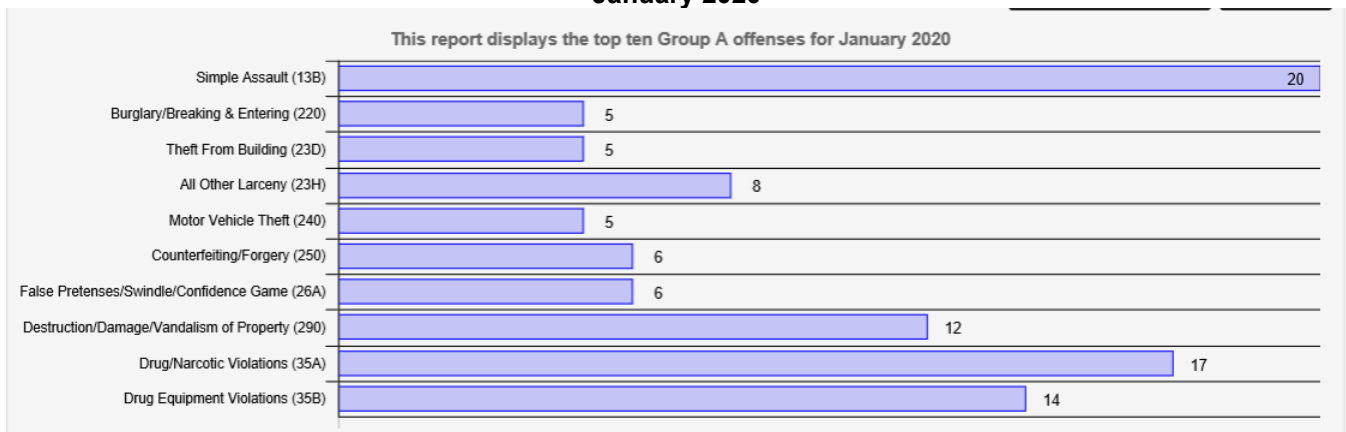

January 2021

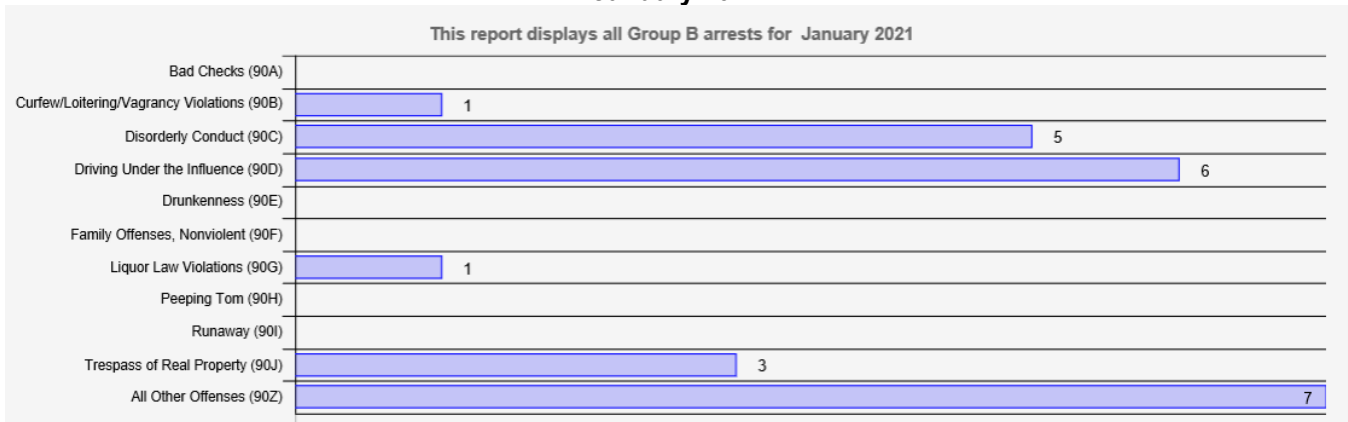

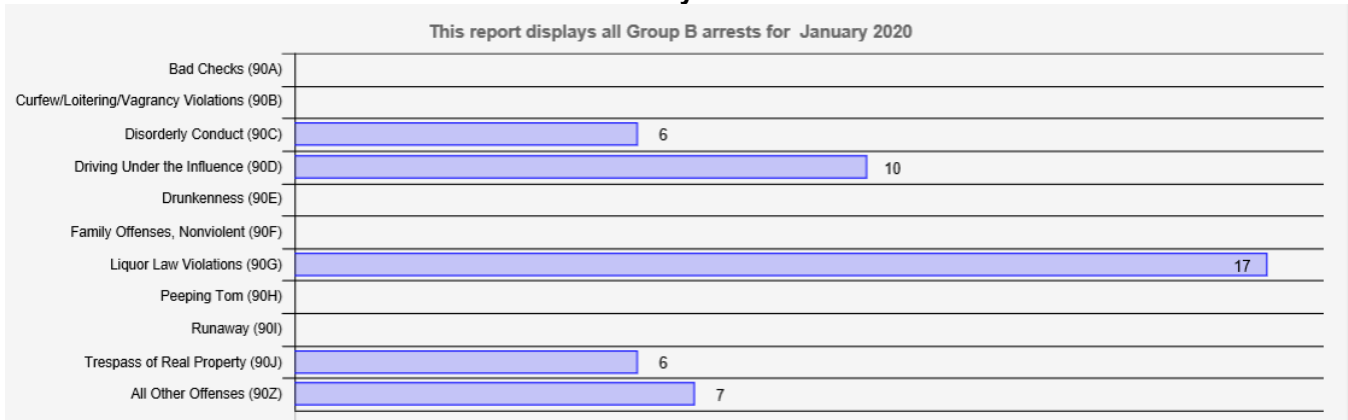


GROUP B ARREST DATA
