

ARRA Airport Sponsor Certification

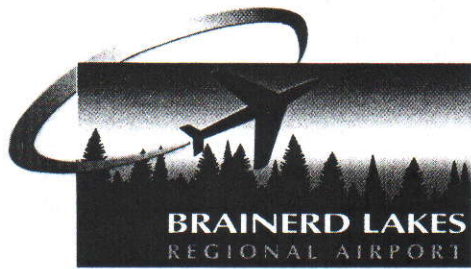
