General

Disc golf is played like ball golf using an flying disc. One point is counted each time the disc is thrown and/or when a penalty occurs. The object is to acquire the lowest score within the par of the course.

Tee Throws

Tee throws must be completed within or behind the designated tee box areas. Please do not throw until the players in front of you are out of range.

Lie

The spot where the previous throw landed.

Throwing Order

After teeing-off, the player's whose disc is farthest from the hole throws first. The player with the fewest number of throws is the first to tee-off on the next hole.

Fairway Throws

Fairway throws must be made with the foot closest to the hole on the lie. The other foot may be no closer to the hole than the lie. A run-up and normal follow-through after release is allowed.

Completion of Hole

A disc that comes to rest in the disc basket or chain constitutes a successful completion of that hole.

Unplayable Lie

Any disc that comes to rest above the ground (tree, shrub, etc) is considered an unplayable lie. The new lie should be established directly below the unplayable lie, unless it must be relocated to avoid damage to vegetation.

Out of Bounds

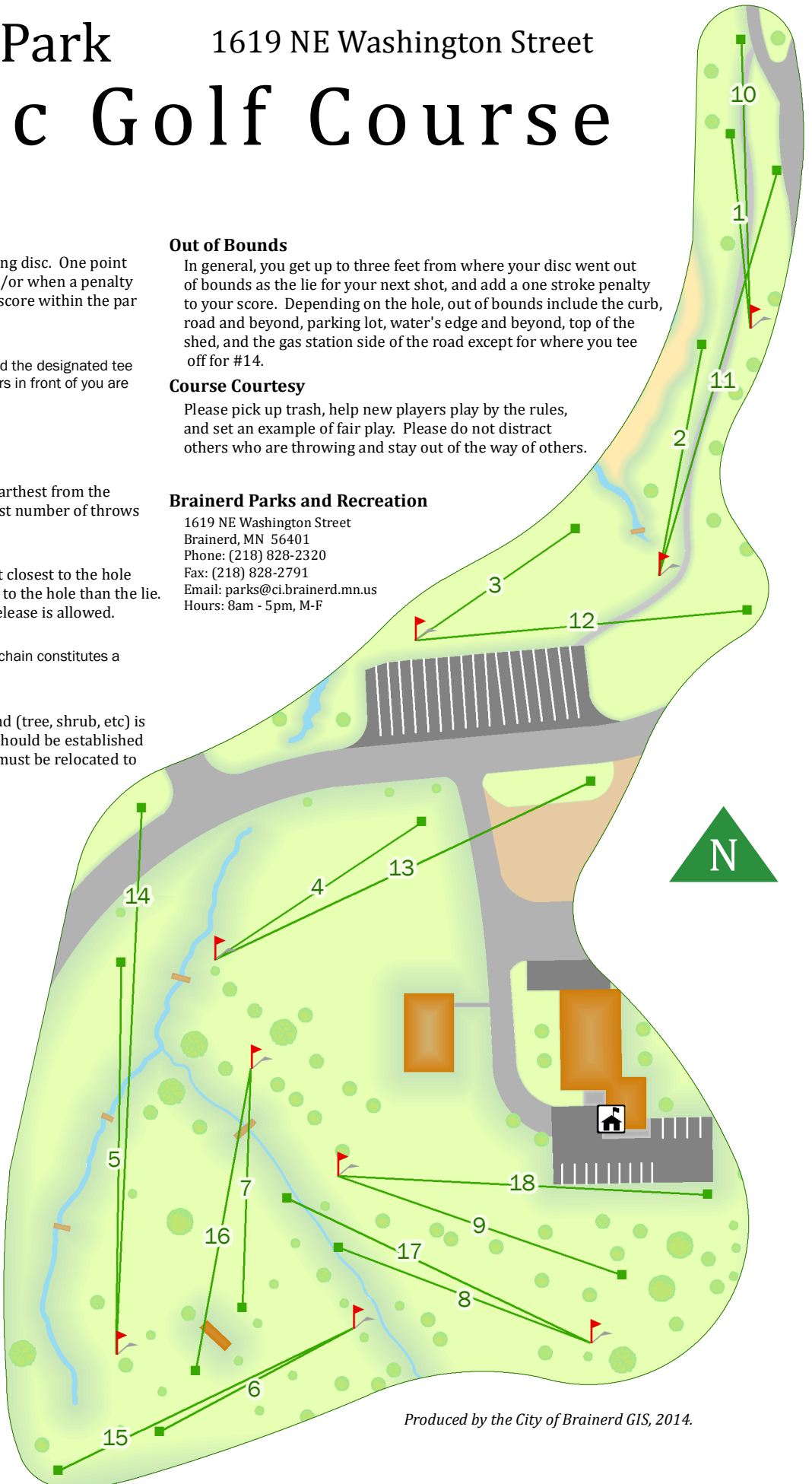
In general, you get up to three feet from where your disc went out of bounds as the lie for your next shot, and add a one stroke penalty to your score. Depending on the hole, out of bounds include the curb, road and beyond, parking lot, water's edge and beyond, top of the shed, and the gas station side of the road except for where you tee off for #14.
