

Appendix L – Self-Evaluation Results – Transit

Overview

City of Brainerd and Crow Wing County Transit

The City of Brainerd, in cooperation with Crow Wing County, operates and maintains a public transit system through a Grant Contract to administer the Public Transit Participation Program under Minnesota Statutes, Section 174.24 with state funds and Federal Transit Administration (FTA) Section 5311 Rural Area Formula Grants Program with FTA funds.

As part of this Contract with the state of Minnesota, the City of Brainerd is required to operate the public transit system in accordance with all applicable federal, state, and local laws, rules, and regulations.

The City of Brainerd contributes a local share of in an amount equal to the percentage of the Total Operating Cost as provided in Minnesota Statutes.

The City of Brainerd uses a third party contractor to operate the bus services under the City of Brainerd Contract with the State of Minnesota.

City of Brainerd and Crow Wing County Transit's Relation to ADA

The City of Brainerd and Crow Wing County Transit operate under State and Federal jurisdiction, and therefore are required to meet all applicable laws pertaining to ADA and ADA compliance.

Self-Evaluation Results

The City of Brainerd and Crow Wing County's transit systems did not have any areas on non-compliance identified in its system. If areas are identified in the future as being non-compliant, a schedule will be implemented to correct the issues.
